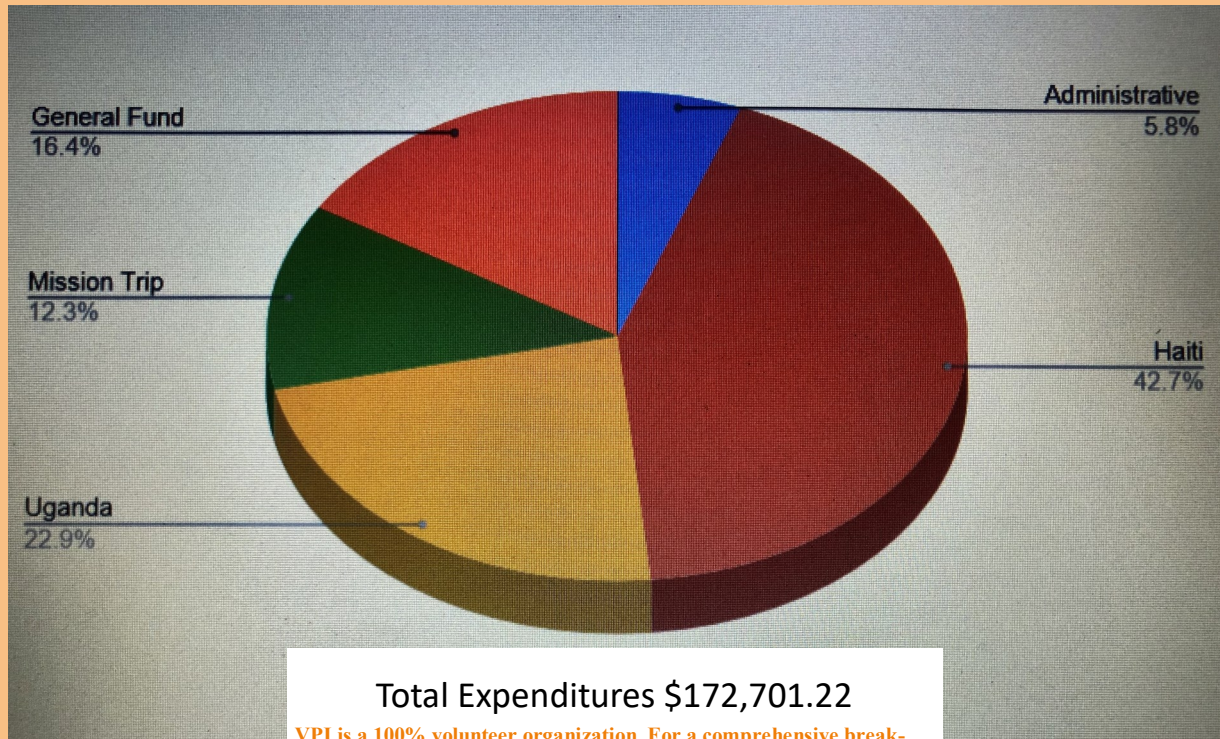

In this time when so much has changed in the world and that which we believed was built on solid ground has crumbled, we hold fast in the belief that God continues to care for all of His children. Through God's grace and the generosity of our donors, much has been accomplished in 2019. In Mombin Crochu, Haiti, a small hospital continues to care for those with no other place to go and the Mobile Clinic reaches those unable to make the journey into town. Clean water is now available for over 50,000 people living in the rural mountains and a Nutrition Program for malnourished children has saved lives and created a safety net for those children who have faced and continue to face starvation. In Papoli, Uganda, children are treated at the Robert H. Cooley Pediatric Clinic which cares for patients with malaria and HIV. Prenatal care and safe deliveries occur at the Jay and Janice Jester Maternity Clinic. Elderly are cared for at the Outpatient Clinic and Public Health initiatives ensure that vaccinations, education, and clean water are available to those in the outlying communities. Outreach continues to migrant workers in Florida at the Beth-El Farmworkers Ministries where much needed supplies are shared.

Through the partnerships we have fostered and the generosity of our donors, the lives of those we serve are changed forever; hope is restored, and God's message of love is shared around the world. Thank you.
